

Supplies: Beads


3 or more players




How to Make Camo Patterns




Jump Rope Tricks

4 or more players*


- 1. Grab a jump rope.
- 2. Write trivia questions with answers.
- 3. Two of the players will start wiggling the jump rope from side it side.
- 4. The first player will try to answer a question from the trivia game. If right, jump over the rope as it wiggles, but try not to let it touch you. If incorrect, try to answer the next question correctly.
- 5. If the jump rope does hit you, it is your turn to wiggle the rope. If you miss two trivia questions in a row, it is your turn to wiggle the rope.



*If in a wheelchair, you can roll over the rope. Then, the people that would wiggle the rope will swing the rope over you.

Next, roll over the rope again. Repeat this 2-3 times and then take a turn wiggling the rope. Have fun!

Supplies: Uno™ Card Game and Yahtzee™ Game (or Five Dice), Writing Utensil, Paper

2 or more players

To play this game, start by rolling the dice and flipping a card. Add up the rolled dice. Match your roll and flip to one of the following scenarios:

- If you have a wild card on top, you have to subtract someone else's points. But, if you have a yellow, green, or red card, you have to subtract that many points from your score.
- If you have a blue card, you get to add 4 to your or someone else's score.
- If you have a reverse or +2 card, you either reverse the order you are going in or add 2 points to your score.

How to Make a Fairy House

Supplies: Branches or Short Sticks, Grass, Rocks, Flowers, Decorations, Cardboard, Small Doll or Fairy Toys

First, you need to put your piece of cardboard down on a flat surface. Second, position the sticks to create a teepee. Third, place grass all over the cardboard. Fourth, create a rock path and decorate the grass with flowers. Last, when you are done decorating, place dolls or fairies onto the design; the dolls or fairies may be glued into place, if desired.

OUTDOOR ACTIVITY:


Chalk Drawing

First, fill up some water balloons.


Next, place all of the water balloons on top of the trampoline. For an extra wet game, fill up water guns, too.

Supplies:

- 1 Empty Toilet Paper Roll
- 4 Pipe Cleaners
- 2 Markers
- Hole Puncher (If You Don't Have One, Use Scissors)
- Add Any Extra Decorations to Preference

First, get the empty toilet paper roll.

Second, get the hole puncher or scissors. On the sides of the toilet paper roll, cut out tiny holes.

Third, take two pipe cleaners. Weave one into each side of the tube.

Fourth, color, put designs, or decorate using the markers or other preferred decorations.

Fifth, hole punch the top front of the roll. Put a pipe cleaner into each of the holes.

Now, you have a beautiful butterfly!





OUTDOOR ACTIVITY:

Hula Hoop Art

Supplies: Hula Hoop, Chalk, Water, Plastic Spoon, Plastic Bowl (Apron and Gloves are Optional)

First, take your plastic bowl and fill it up with some water, but do not overfill.

Then, pick your color of chalk. Place the chalk in the bowl and stir with plastic spoon. Repeat the first two steps with various colors, if desired.



Wait until the chalk has disintegrated so all your color will be in the bowl. Then, get your hula hoop and pick color of your choice.

Now trace around your hula hoop to make a circle. Then grab your mixture of chalk you just made and splatter it into your circle.


Repeat the second two steps as many times to achieve your desired effect and design.
